English Tour "Mercedes-Benz in the context of German history" (15€ Entrance +7€ Tour = 22€pp)

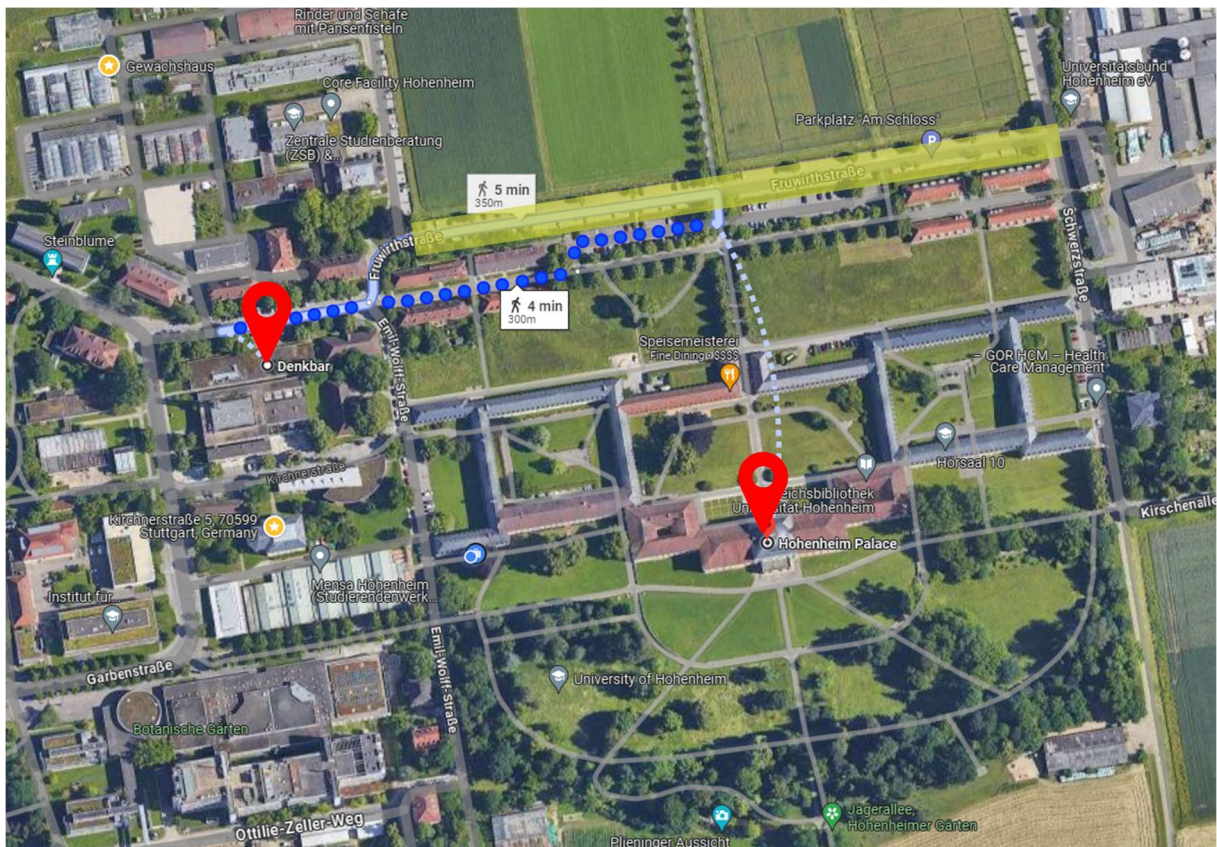
Parking
